Regular Business Meeting

The meeting was called to order by Chair Mike Paschall at 6:05 P.M. With a quorum present new members, Maggie Olson, Primary and Carin Karr, Alternate member from the Family Medical Center were introduced. Present were: Flower Cole, Tim Tuckwood, Ron Magee, Janice Templin-Weller, Rachelle Hill, Mike Paschall, John Lewis, Dave Zimmerman, Finance Officer, and Doris Fales, Secretary.

The minutes were presented. A motion by Ron Magee was made to accept the minutes as presented. Flower Cole seconded and the motion was passed.

The Financial Report was presented. Discussion followed. Janice Weller requested to use monies to help the Mass Dispensing Clinic. It was agreed to contact Homeland Security with information for this activity. Mike Paschall agreed to do this. Ron Magee requested that more brochures for outreach were needed if the money is available.

The Chair stated that Kelly Kohnen and Al Edgren had, according to the LEPC By-Laws, having missed many business meetings without being excused, needed to be removed from membership in this organization. A motion was made by Janice Weller to remove Kelly Kohnen and Al Edgren as members, and seconded by Rachelle Hill. The Secretary stated letters of thanks had been sent to them for their hard work in the past. The motion carried.

Committee Reports: Rachelle Hill presented the changes to the recommended Emergency Operations Plan. Amendments and changes were discussed. It was agreed all members will receive the E.O.P. Plan. Action will be taken at the next meeting, April 13, 2010. for acceptance of the Plan.

Outreach and Public Health exercise will be held at the Mormon Church. The Emergency Exercise Preparedness will be held Saturday the 20th from 12:00 noon to 2 P.M. at the Mormon Church. Ron Magee spoke on the possibility of renting water purifiers from John Dufendoch. The LEPC should possibly recommend this to the School District and City. Dave Zimmerman stated he would mention this to Mr. Twengy at City Hall. Mike Paschall will call about the brochures for Outreach.

Janice Weller reported on the Public Health Vaccine Clinic on February 17th. Discussion followed. An ad will be placed in the paper locally with News on the Website. A few more volunteers will be needed along with I.D. Badges for workers. Senior Center Lounge will be used for breaks. Flower Cole will coordinate water, snacks, etc.

The Chair reported that ICS classes will be available in March and he will look into the dates, etc. Mike Paschall also reported that the SERC/LEPC meeting will be held March 22 -26th. Maggie Olson and Flower Cole volunteered to attend.

Janice Weller announced that she would be retiring from her position with the State Public Health Department as of May 31st. Sgt. Tuckwood also stated that he would be moving to Dillingham soon,

but will attend the next LEPC meeting and nominate a replacement for the Law Enforcement position.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 P.M.
