MINUTES

The workshop was called to order by Mayor Gilbertson with council members Mark Weller, Mary Leith-Dowling, Susie Kemp, Lou Heinbockel and Nat Good present. Henry Summers was excused. Also in attendance were Pete Hallgren, Kelley Hegarty and Nancy Webb. Lamar Cotten was present telephonically.

Council met with Hegarty and Associates to discuss the Community Impact Fund Request they are developing for the City. The City must plan now for the future. The request is due on September 4, 2001 to NMD.

Discussed was a list of needs to serve the community affected by the impact of development and in-migration due to the development of the National Missile Defense and anticipated development at the Pogo Mine.

Included were the needs for new emergency service equipment, landfill, television and radio services, school, library, city hall, a recreational facility, training facilities, road improvements, and other concerns facing the community. These will all be issues facing the growth of the community should the proposed development come to the area.

Council will meet again to discuss a final draft on August 31, 2001.
